Beginning Birdwatching

The Forgotten Coast is a fantastic area for birdwatching, and here's an "info-taining" crash-course (for beginners and a refresher for seasoned birders) designed to answer some of the most frequently asked questions about birding in Florida.

You'll learn: What species of birds are in our area and their populations; all about the latest free apps for bird identification and participating in citizenscience projects; where the local "hot spots" are for birdwatching; how to bring more birds into your backyard; what the upcoming Spring migration means to the Panhandle and how to forecast arrivals; all about the popular Florida Audubon EagleWatch program; bird identification skills; and how you can plug-in to the rapidly growing Gulf County birding community.

Intermediate Birdwatching

You asked for more, and here it is!

Here's an opportunity to sharpen your skills with more in depth and entertaining birdwatching classes.Topics during the second period intermediate classes will focus on feather identification; some basic bird anatomy and behavior; how to attract birds to your backyard throughout the year and set up the perfect bird garden; a deeper dive into birding optics (binoculars, scopes and cameras); and we'll even have a lab day to dissect owl pellets for those who've participated in the beginners owl class! Tai Chi: Mindfulness in Motion

In this course, the focus will be on perfecting the techniques for 24 posture sequences, proper breathing, and flow of movement. Tai Chi has gained recognition as a low-impact exercise, which promotes improved circulation, flexibility, strength, and balance. A recent study found that individual who practiced Tai Chi 1-3 times a week reduced their rate of falls by 43%! *Instructor: Brooks Jones Location: M105*

CHECK the two boxes to the left of the pop-up window to accept the Terms of Use. **CLICK** the yellow "Next" button.

- Gender

CLICK the yellow "Continue" button.
